Grade 1	851. Medley (5-7 minutes) 852. March, Strathspey & Reel (submit two sets, each tune minimum four parts)

PIPING, DRUMMING AND PIPE BANDS RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All piping, drumming and pipe band events are governed by the rules of the BC Pipers Association
2. Solo competitors will play in reverse order of entry. Draw for bands will be conducted the day after entries close. Orders of play will be posted on the BCPA website at minimum one week before the Games.
3. Competitors not ready to play in the posted order may be disqualified at the discretion of the Steward for the event.
4. The Chief Steward reserves the right to set the order of play and to change said order of play in the individual piping, drumming and pipe band competition.
5. The Competition Committee reserves the right to cancel any event if insufficient entries.
6. All entries must be accompanied by applicable entry fees made payable to the “**BC Pipers Association**”. There will be NO refunds.
7. \$50.00 appearance money will be paid to bands that perform in massed bands at opening ceremony (approx. 12:30 PM). **Following massed bands in the opening ceremonies, there shall be no piping or drumming until open ceremonies is finished.** Bands must participate in closing massed bands in order to receive prize money.
8. All competitors will receive an admission pass. If not presented at gate, admission will be charged.
9. Event 812 is for entry level bands only. If less than three Grade 5 pipe bands enter, this event will be cancelled and combined with the Grade 4 pipe band competition and the best Grade 5 pipe band will be announced during the awards presentation.
10. Pipe Bands may challenge up one grade only if indicated at time of entry and if time permits. Bands desiring to challenge up must enter for all the events in their regular grade and the event(s) they are challenging up. Prize money for only one grade will be awarded (whichever is highest)
11. **All bands must set up prior to 8:00 A.M.** No vehicles will be allowed on field.
12. As the Sons of Scotland Highland Games must adhere to the rules and regulations as set out by Delta Parks & Recreation, **No persons are permitted to barbecue or prepare lunches for groups on field. There are concessions available for food. Alcohol must be confined to beer tent only.** We appreciate your cooperation on these matters.
