GENERAL INFORMATION

VENUE

Kings Park, 550 Eckhardt Avenue West, Penticton, BC.
Gates open at 7:30 am (Competitors) and 8:00 am (General Public).

SCHEDULE

Solo competitions begin at 8:30 am. Opening Ceremonies and Massed Bands at 12:30 pm. Pipe Band competitions begin at approximately 2 pm. Closing Ceremonies and Massed Bands are directly after the final band event (approximately 5 pm).

Depending on the number of entries, events may start earlier. All events subject to time change.

ADMISSION

Admission tickets for solo competitors and bands will be delivered to their band representative. Solo competitors who are not a member of a band competing at the Penticton Scottish Festival should pick up their admission ticket at the WILL CALL booth at the entrance to the Park.

The number of passes for band members will be based on the player roster officially registered with the BCPA Membership Chair (membership@bcpipers.org) as of June 14, 2014. Competitors who do not present an admission ticket will have to pay admission, which is not refundable.

AFTER PARTY

An after party will commence in the Beer Garden right after Closing Ceremonies and Massed Bands and run until 8 pm. There will be an impromptu open Hornpipe & Jig competition in the Beer Garden. Prizes will be available to be won.

RULES

Penticton Scottish Festival events in solo piping, solo drumming, and pipe bands are conducted under the rules of the BC Pipers Association.

All bands are required to perform in BOTH Opening and Closing Massed Bands to be eligible for prize and travel monies.

ORDER OF PLAY

Orders of play for Professional Piping, Side, and Tenor Drumming, and Bands will be determined by random draw. The random draw will take place at 8 pm June 17 at the Penticton Scottish Festival Competition Secretary's address. All other events are *first to enter, last to play*, however all "early bird" entries received by 11:59 pm May 10 will be considered to be randomly received on May 10.

All orders of play will be posted by June 28 on the Events section of the Penticton Scottish Festival web site (www.pentictonscottishfestival.ca) and at 8 am at the Competition Secretary's area on Games day.

Competitors not ready to play in the posted order may be disqualified.

TUNE SELECTION

Tune selection for solo events conducted by the judge at time competitor presents to perform, except for Professional Side Drumming (at 8 am on competition day). For band events, selection of MSR (Grades 1 & 2) will be conducted by Chief Steward when band is at the starting line.

PRIZES

For solo events other than Professional, prizes are medals. For solo Professional and Band events, monetary prizes are awarded. The aggregate winner in each grade receives a perpetual trophy.

For solo events, the number and value (CDN \$) of prizes shall be awarded as shown in both tables. For band events, the number and value (CDN \$) of prizes is as shown in the second table.
